◆Blazer

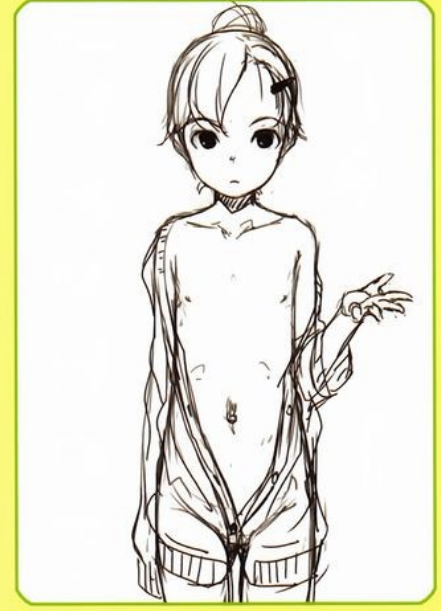
It sounds like brassiere

This time's rough illustrations



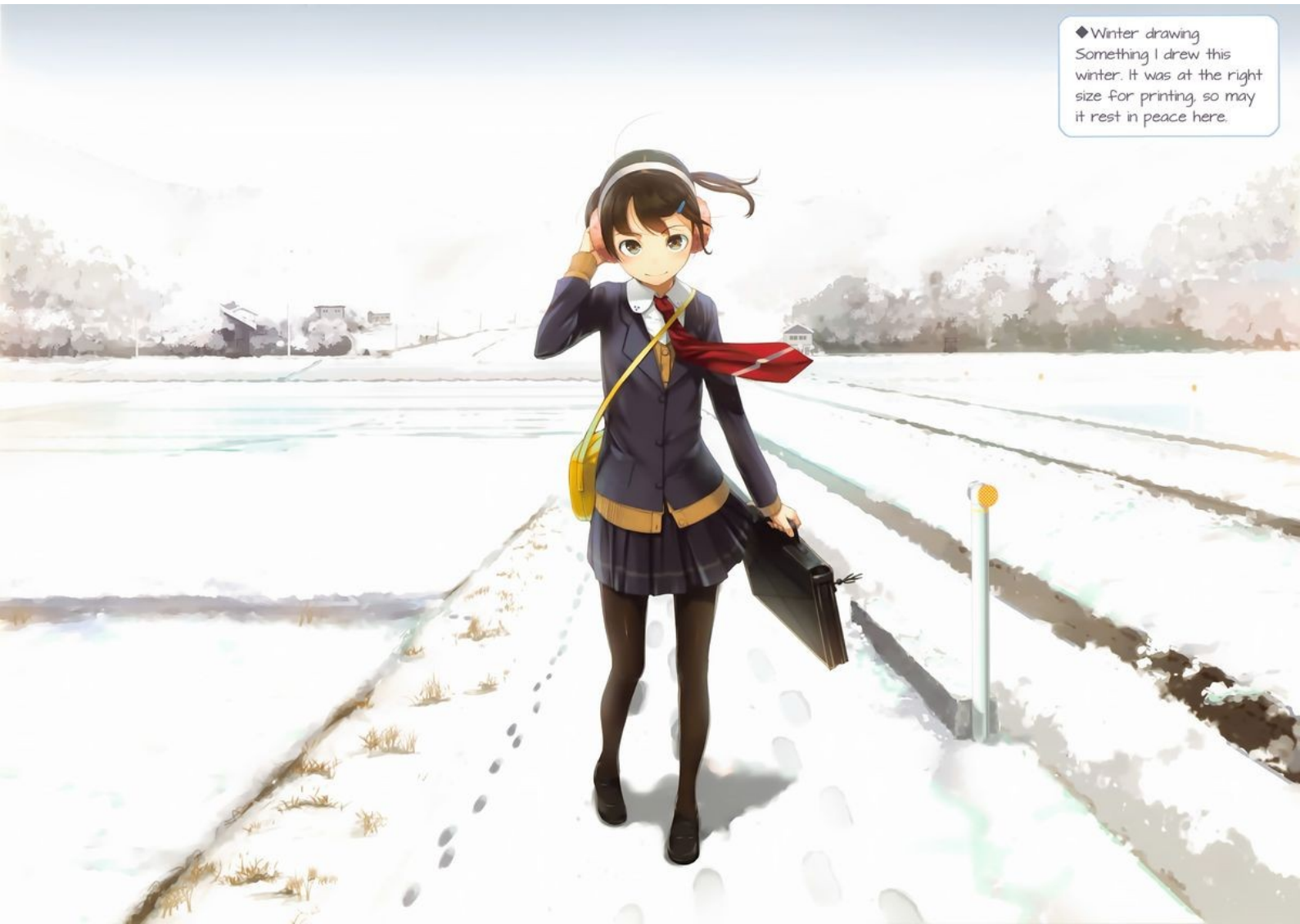
◆ Underwear drawing

May it rest in peace here.



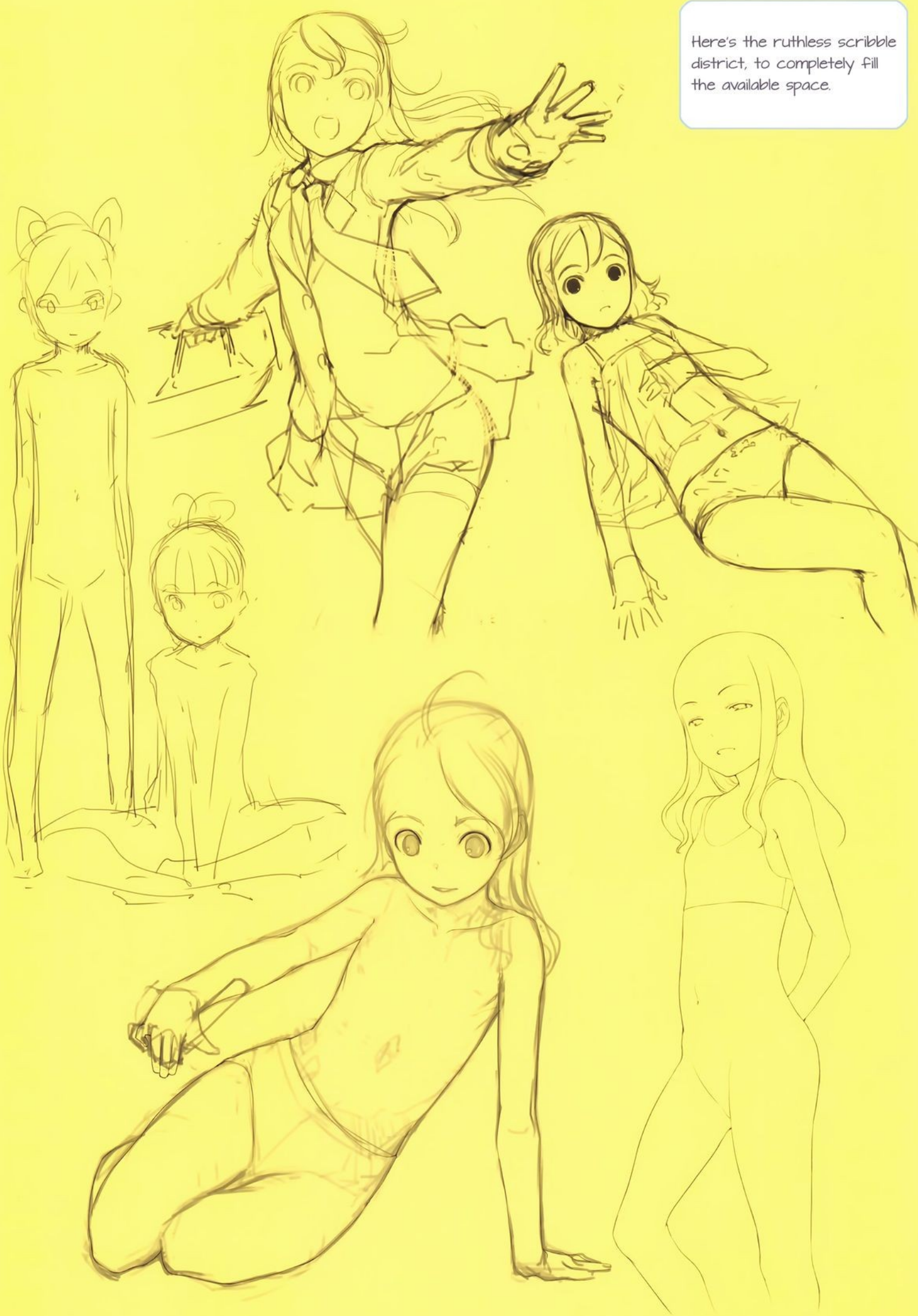


◆ Winter drawing

Here's the ruthless scribble district, to completely fill the available space.



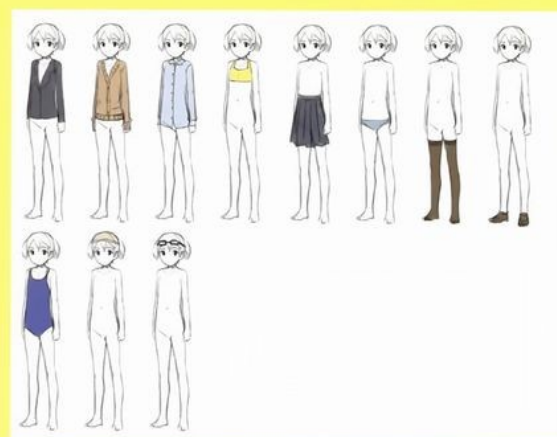


postscript
