Operating Room



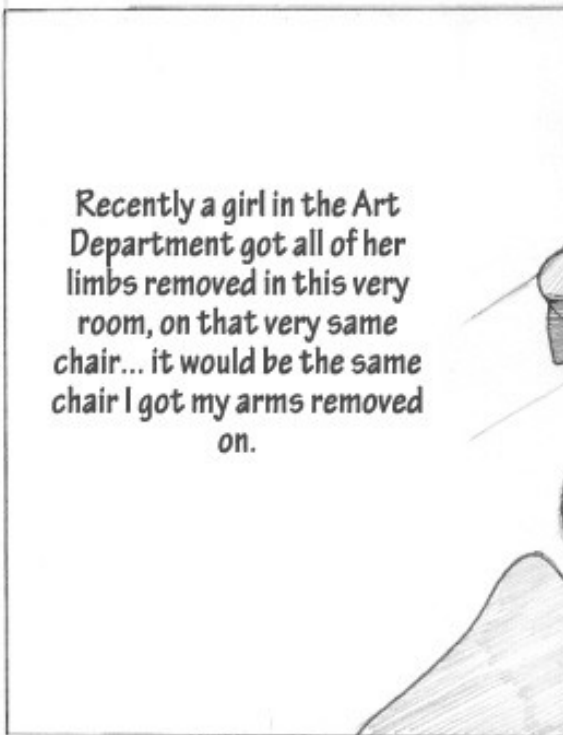
Despite my many concerns, they made me move forward with the operation. My big sister was also part of the Art Department and was crucified... since then, nothing was off-limits.

They covered my left shoulder in a tea-colored antiseptic medicine.

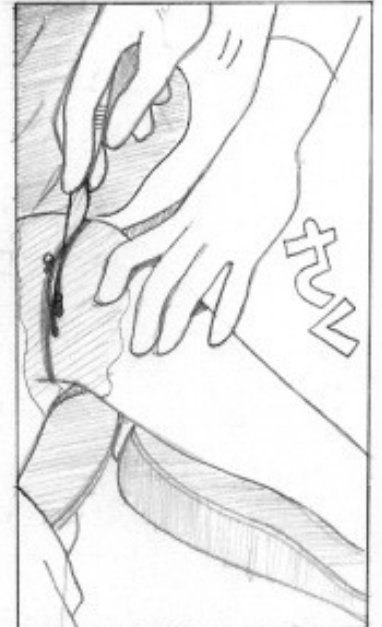
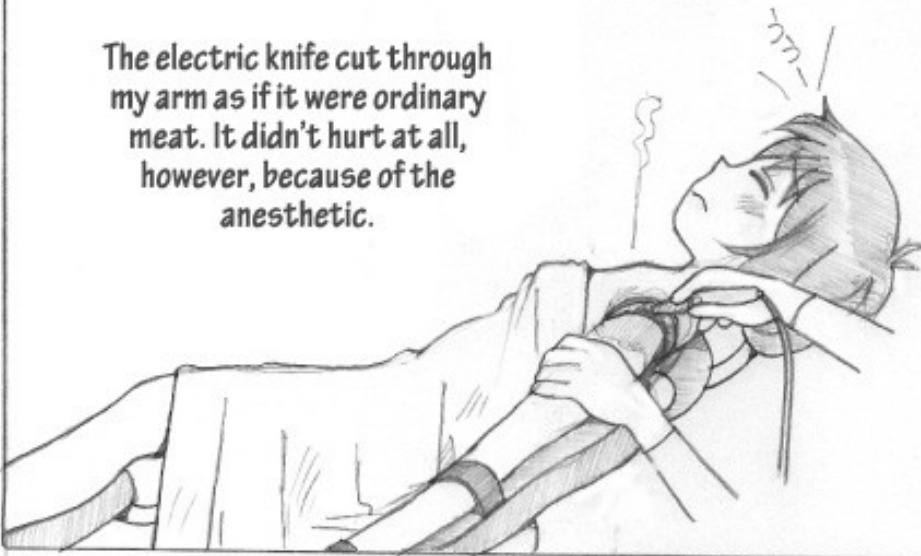


My arms felt real heavy, and they strapped them to the table with belts. I heard them say they were going to begin on the left arm.

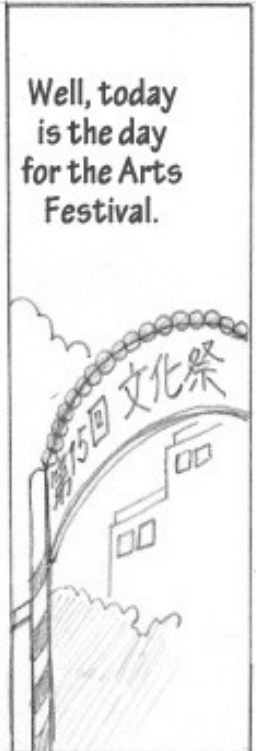


Well, it's finally time...

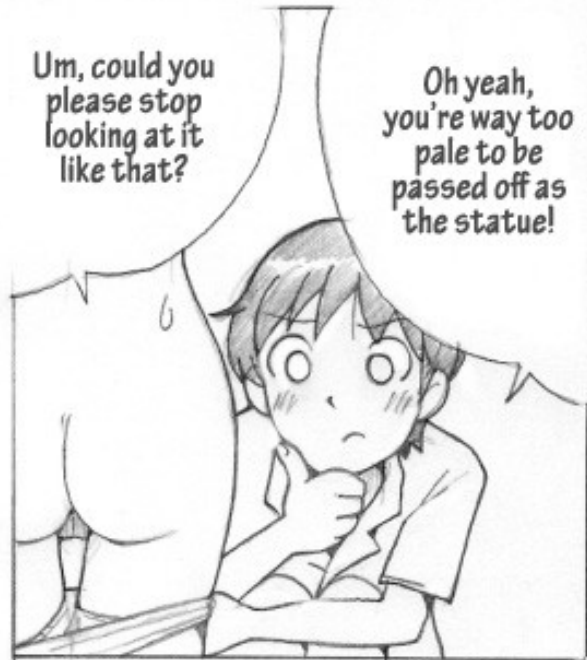
Now let's get this stuff off!

So, then I was shaved...



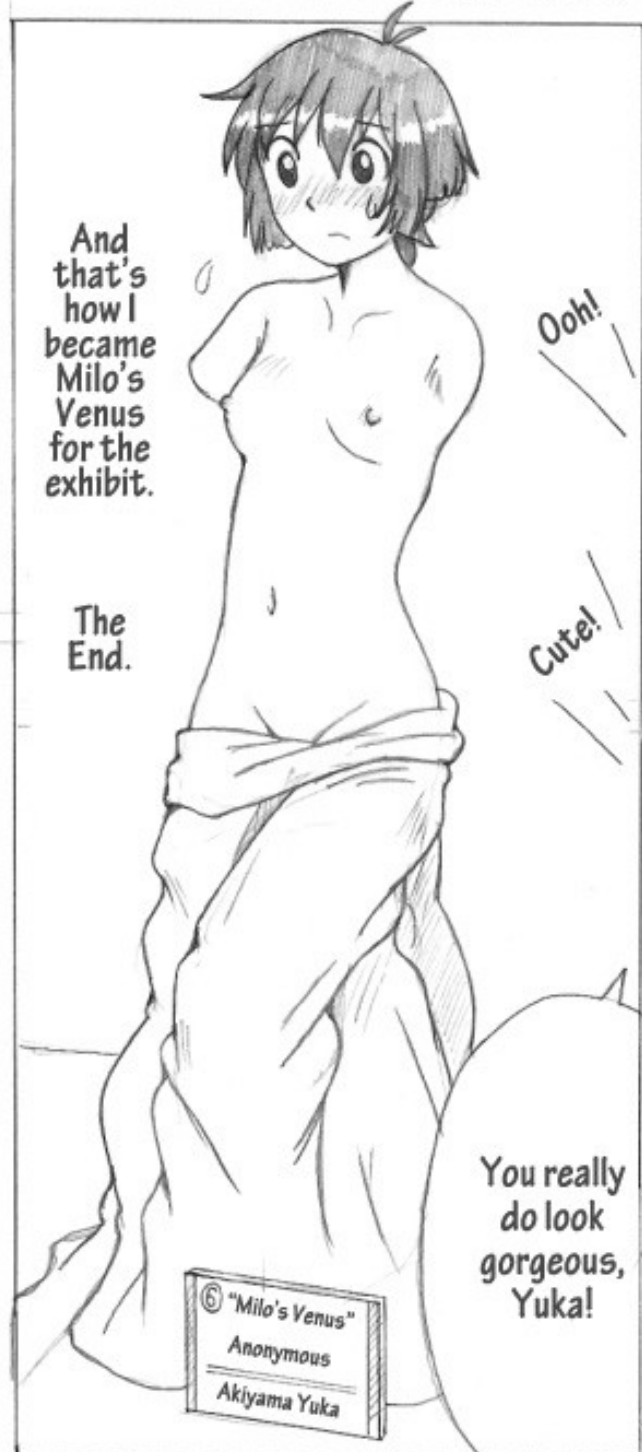
"So, here we are!"
