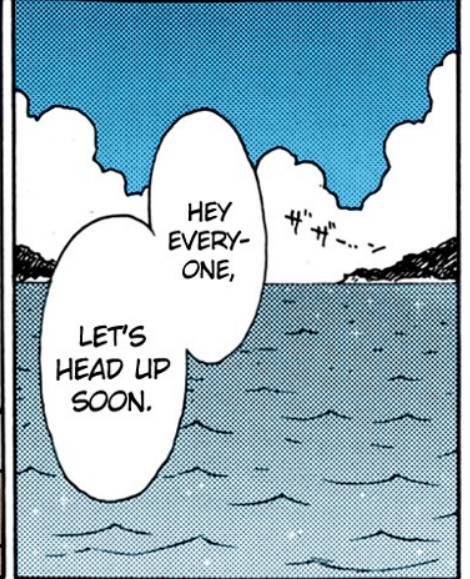
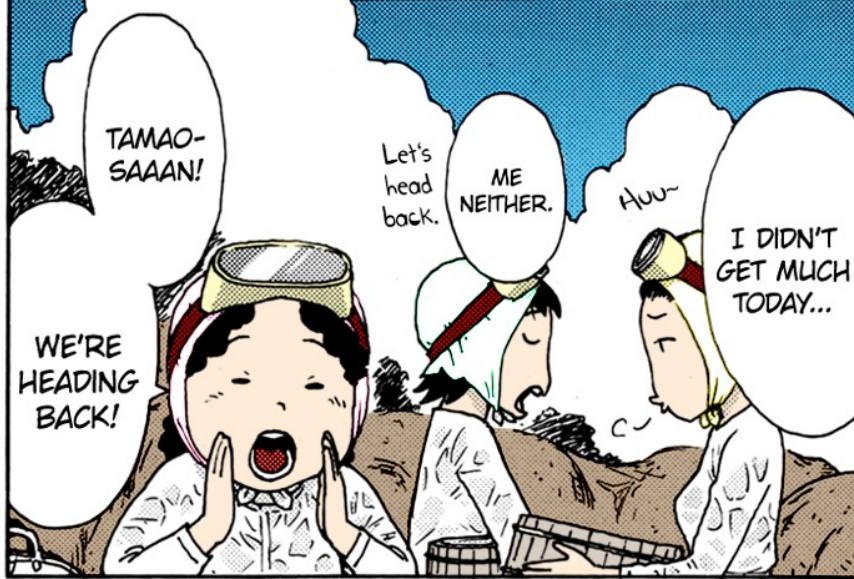
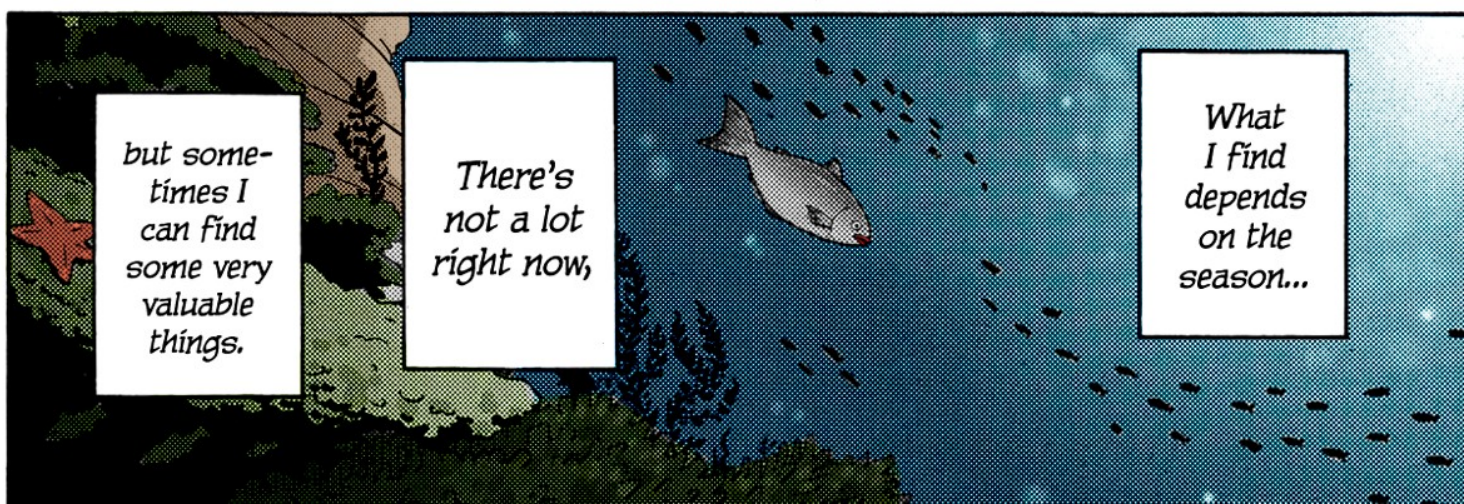
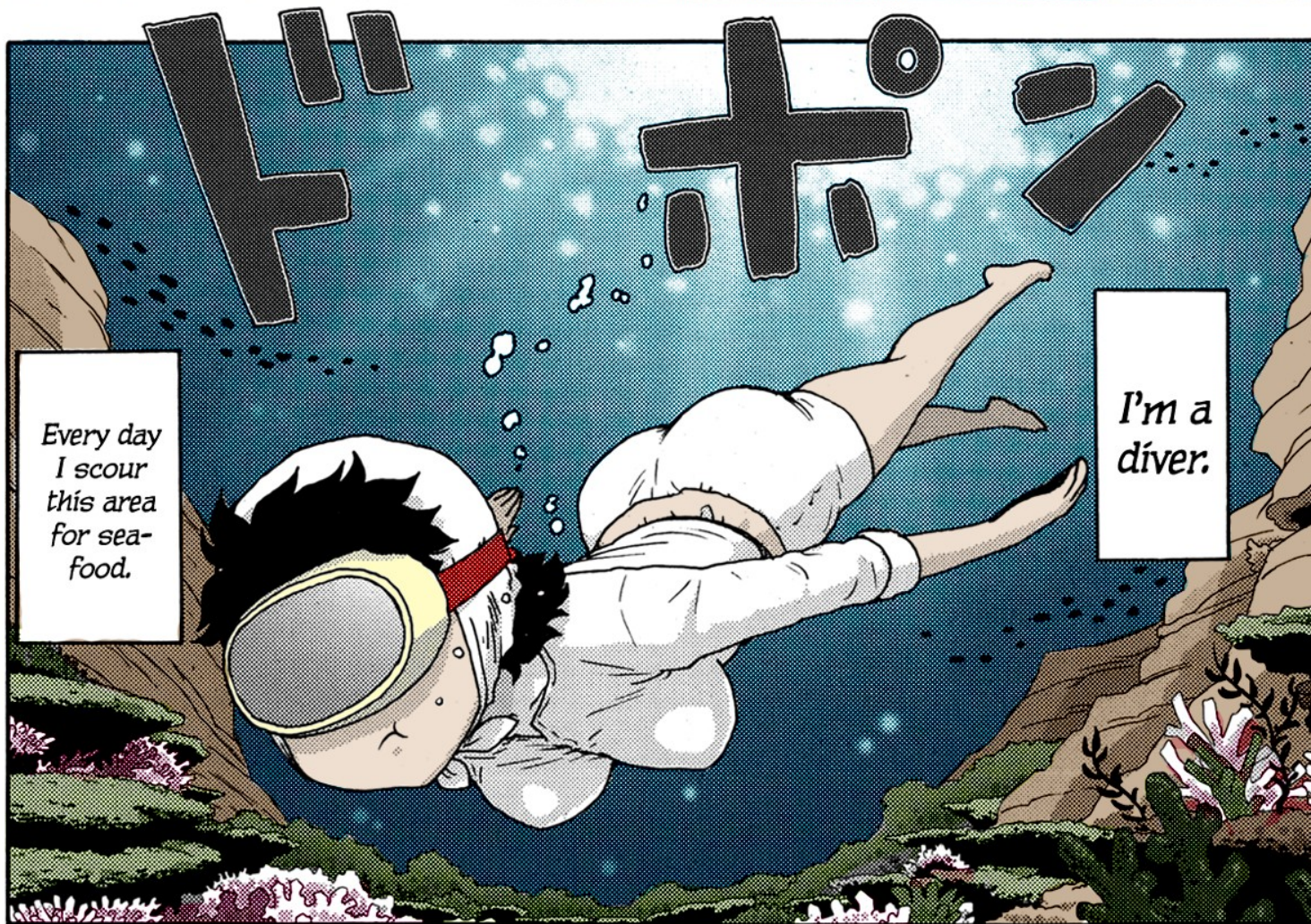
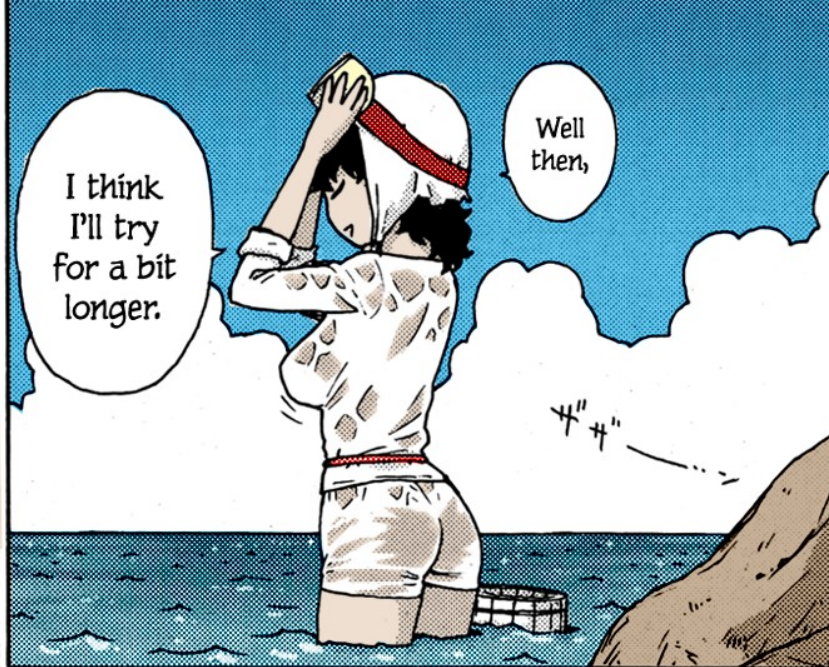
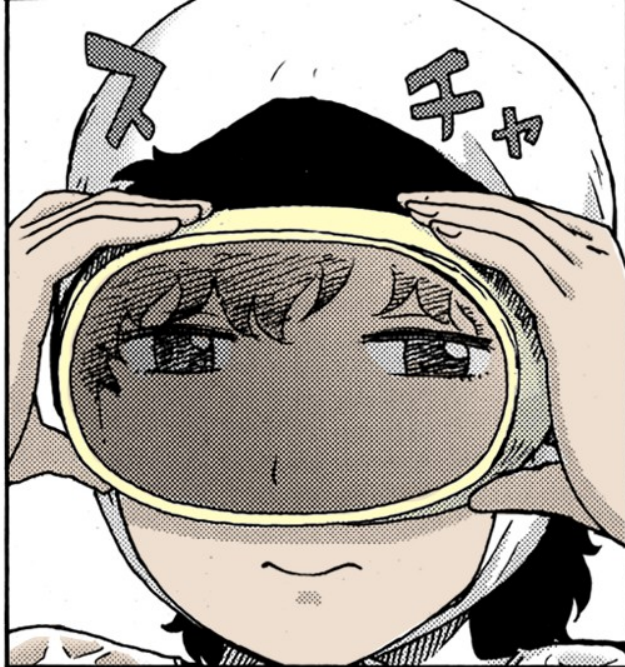






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Though it may not look it, it is in fact a shellfish.

Even fishermen are forbidden from picking it.

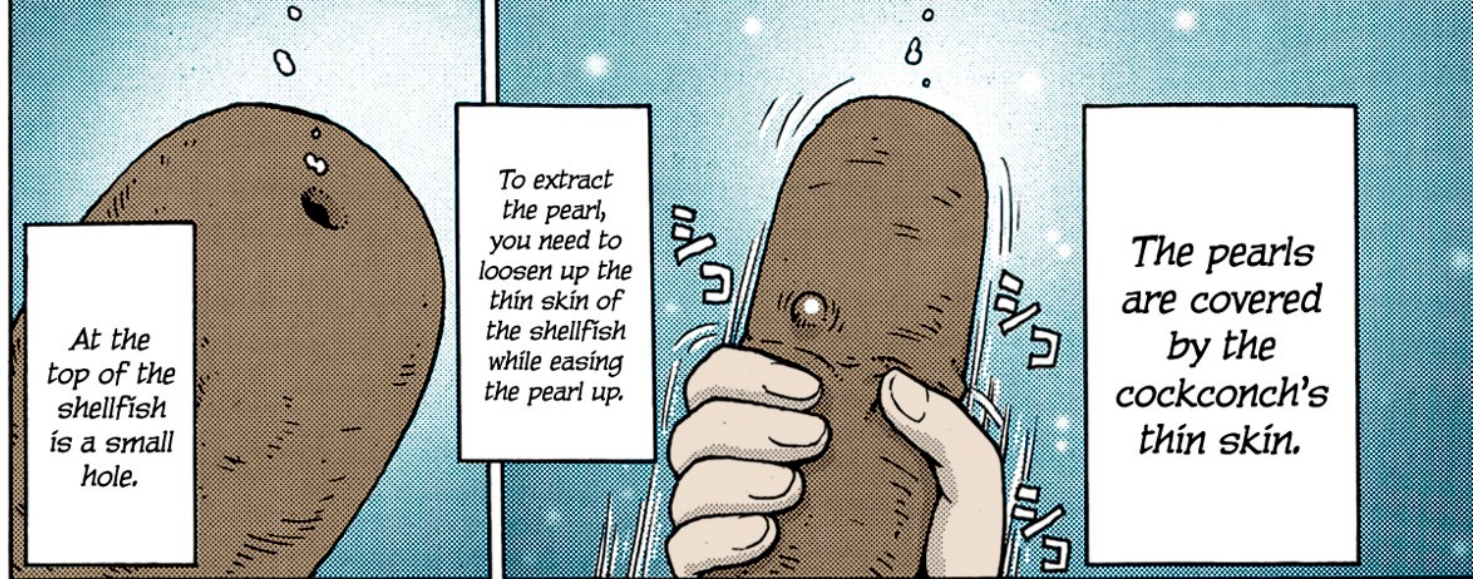
However, the cockconch is a rare species and thus few in number...

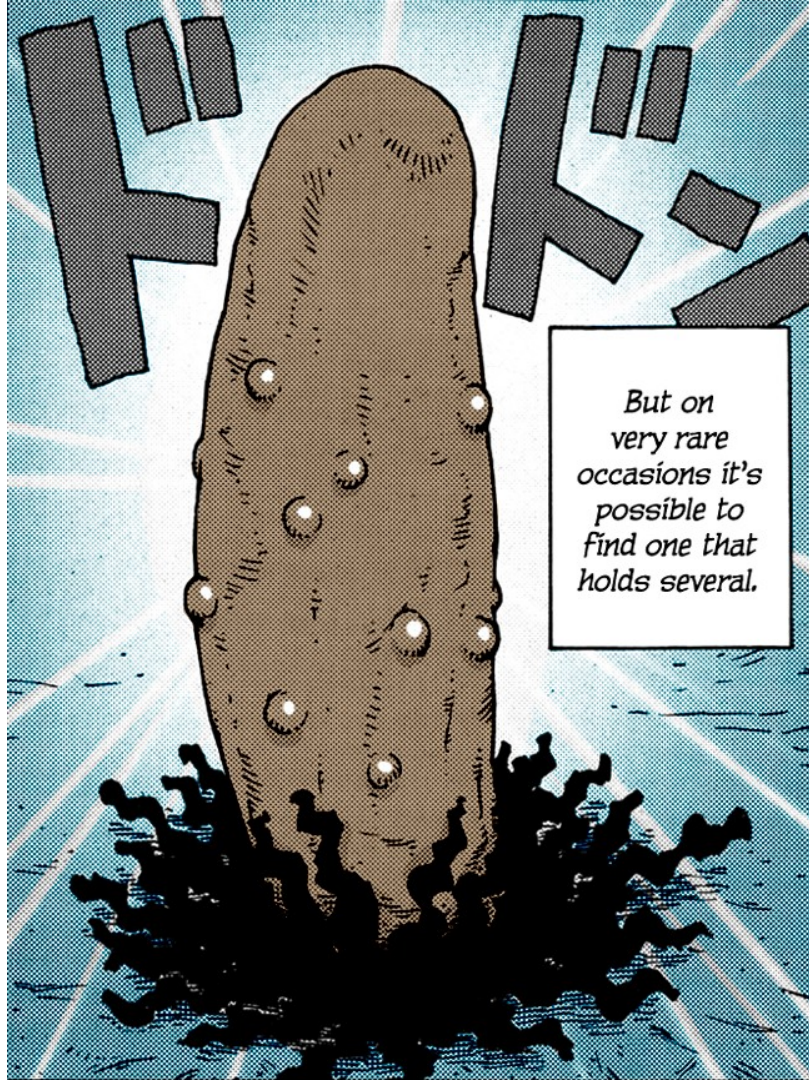
from this shellfish are its pearls.

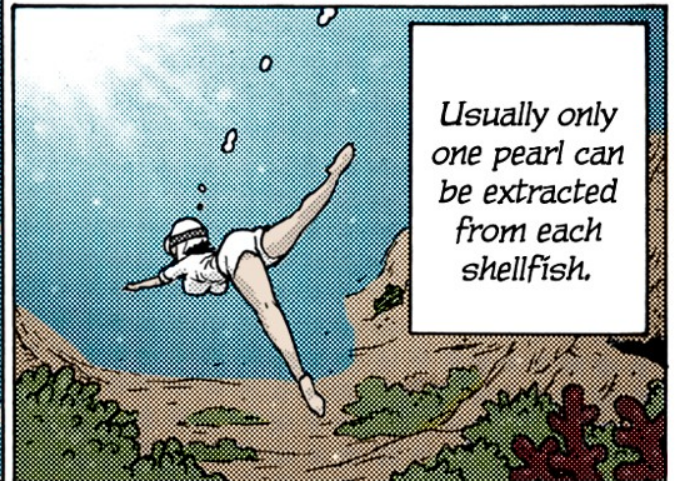
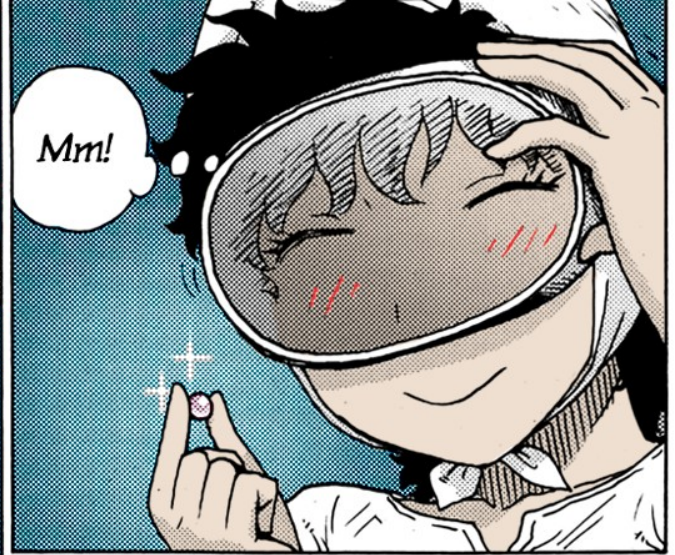
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But on very rare occasions it's possible to find one that holds several.



Usually only one pearl can be extracted from each shellfish.



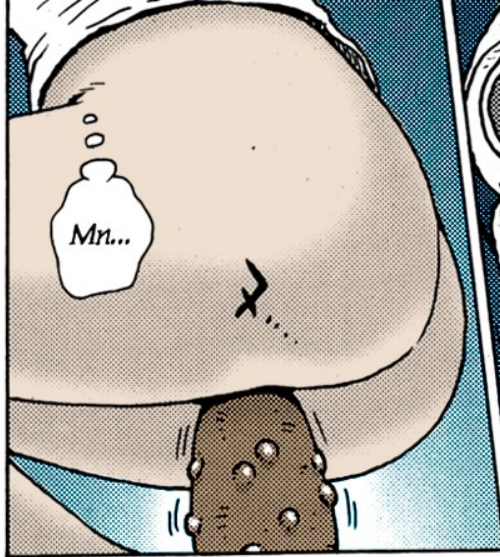
Large shellfish typically hold a large number of pearls.



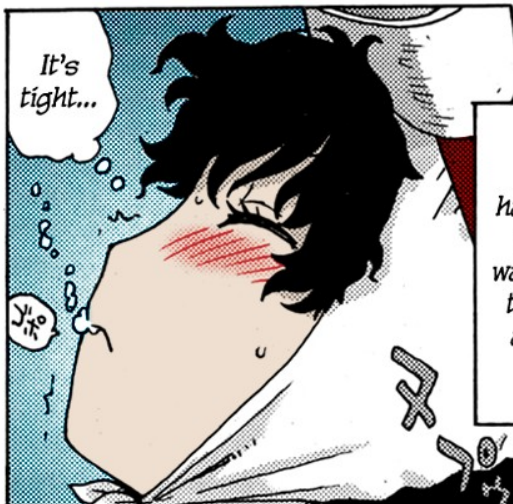
and there's a high chance that you'll get hurt when the shellfish starts to struggle.

At those times, you need to use this place instead of your mouth.



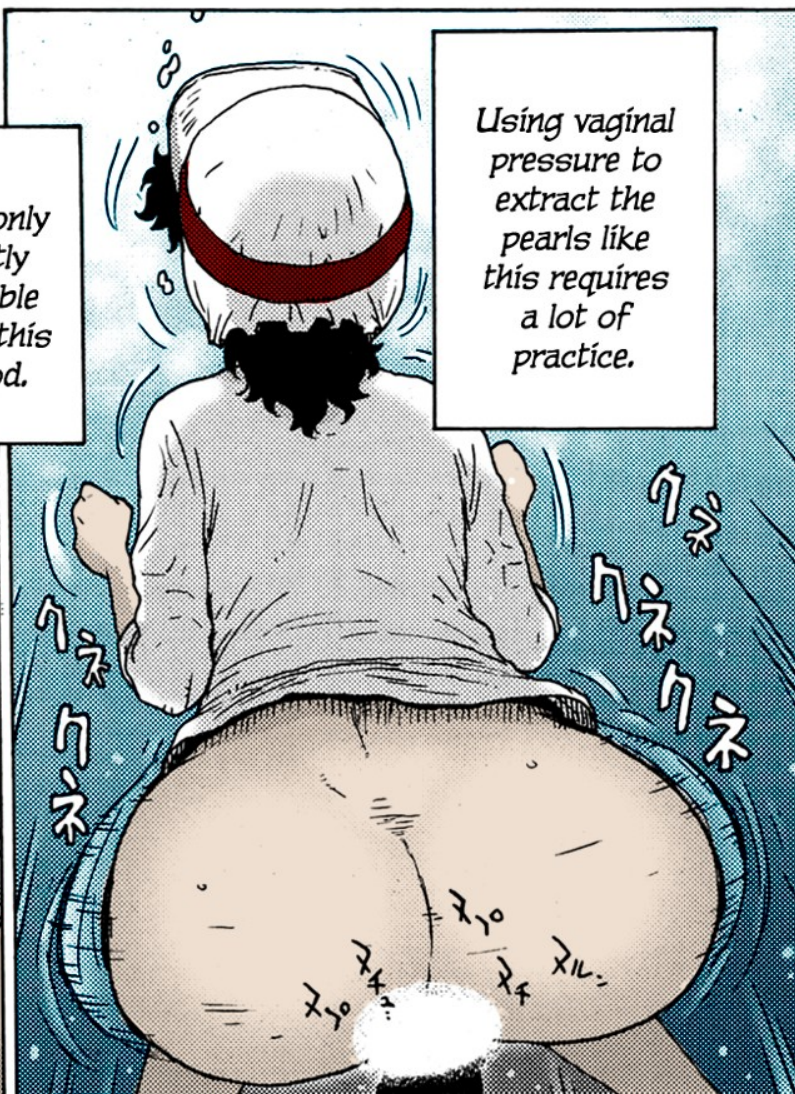
This harvesting method was taught to me by a senior diver.
